Numbers (1 to 100) क्या हैं?

Numbers मतलब गिनती. Hindi wale 1,2,3 ko English mein बोलते हैं one, two, three...

1 से 20 – याद करना easy hai (ratta bas):

One (1), Two (2), Three (3), Four (4), Five (5), Six (6), Seven (7), Eight (8), Nine (9), Ten (10)

Eleven (11), Twelve (12), Thirteen (13), Fourteen (14), Fifteen (15), Sixteen (16), Seventeen (17), Eighteen (18), Nineteen (19), Twenty (20)

Tens – multiples of 10:

20 = Twenty

30 = Thirty

40 = Forty

50 = Fifty

60 = Sixty

70 = Seventy

80 = Eighty

90 = Ninety

100 = One Hundred

After 20, bas rule simple:

21 = Twenty-one

22 = Twenty-two

...

99 = Ninety-nine

Easy boss! बस “tens + ones” combine karo aur number बन गया।

Dates (तारीख)

Dates matlab calendar wali dates.

Formula: **Day + Month + Year**

- Today is 5th May 2025. = आज 5 मई 2025 है।

Ordinal Numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd, 4th...):

1 = first

2 = second

3 = third

4 = fourth

5 = fifth

...

10 = tenth

21 = twenty-first

22 = twenty-second

31 = thirty-first

Example:

- My birthday is on 10th August. (मेरा जन्मदिन 10 अगस्त को है।)

Time (समय)

Time बताना English mein easy hai. बस ध्यान दो

(1) Hour + Minute

Example:

- It is 5 o'clock. = अभी 5 बजे हैं।
- It is 5:30. = अभी 5 बजकर 30 मिनट (साढ़े पाँच)।

(2) A.M. & P.M.

A.M. = सुबह (00:00 से 11:59 तक)

P.M. = दोपहर/शाम/रात (12:00 से 23:59 तक)

Example:

- 8:00 A.M. = सुबह 8 बजे
- 8:00 P.M. = शाम 8 बजे

(3) Special Words

- 15 minutes = quarter past (पौना)
- 30 minutes = half past (साढ़े)
- 45 minutes = quarter to (पौने)

Example:

- 7:15 = quarter past seven (सवा सात बजे)

- 7:30 = half past seven (साढ़े सात बजे)
- 7:45 = quarter to eight (पौने आठ बजे)

Example Sentences (20)

Numbers

- (1) I have two books. = मेरे पास दो किताबें हैं।
- (2) She bought ten apples. = उसने 10 सेब खरीदे।
- (3) We are five friends. = हम पाँच दोस्त हैं।
- (4) My phone is on the 7th floor. = मेरा फोन 7वीं मंज़िल पर है।
- (5) There are 100 students in the class. = क्लास में 100 छात्र हैं।

Dates

- (6) Today is 1st January. = आज 1 जनवरी है।
- (7) My birthday is on 15th July. = मेरा जन्मदिन 15 जुलाई को है।
- (8) Independence Day is on 15th August. = स्वतंत्रता दिवस 15 अगस्त को है।
- (9) Christmas is on 25th December. = क्रिसमस 25 दिसंबर को है।
- (10) The exam is on 20th March. = परीक्षा 20 मार्च को है।

Time

- (11) It is 6 o'clock. = अभी 6 बजे हैं।
- (12) The train leaves at 9 A.M. = ट्रेन सुबह 9 बजे जाती है।
- (13) The party is at 8 P.M. = पार्टी रात 8 बजे है।
- (14) It is half past ten. = अभी साढ़े 10 बजे हैं।
- (15) It is quarter past five. = अभी सवा 5 बजे हैं।
- (16) It is quarter to seven. = अभी पौने 7 बजे हैं।
- (17) School starts at 8:30 A.M. = स्कूल सुबह 8:30 बजे शुरू होता है।
- (18) Dinner is at 9 P.M. = रात का खाना 9 बजे है।
- (19) I sleep at 11 P.M. = मैं रात 11 बजे सोता हूँ।
- (20) I wake up at 6 A.M. = मैं सुबह 6 बजे उठता हूँ।
