

Chapter 46: Future Forms – Will vs Going to (Prediction vs Plans)

Arre boss! आज हम future ki taraf dekhenge – matlab aane wala samay. English mein future bolne ke do mast tareeke hote hain – will aur going to. Lekin kab konsa use karna hai, ye sabko confuse karta hai . So relax, main aaj tumhe ekdum easy aur funny style mein clear kar dunga!

Will (क्या है?)

- **Will** = promises, instant decisions, aur predictions (future guessing).
- Formula: Subject + will + verb (base form).
Hindi signals: “होगा”, “करूँगा”, “बनूँगा”

Example:

- I will call you tomorrow. = मैं तुम्हें कल कॉल करूँगा।
- It will rain today. = आज बारिश होगी।

Going to (क्या है?)

- Going to = plans ya intentions (soch liya hai, decide already).
- Formula: Subject + am/is/are + going to + verb.
Hindi signals: “जाने वाला हूँ”, “करने वाला हूँ”, “योजना है”

Example:

- I am going to study tonight. = मैं आज रात पढ़ने वाला हूँ।
- They are going to buy a new car. = वे नई कार खरीदने वाले हैं।

कब Use करें?

(1) **Will** → Jab prediction, promise, ya turant decision ho.

- Don't worry, I will help you.

(2) **Going to** → Jab tum plan bana चुके ho ya koi pakki niyat hai.

- I am going to visit my grandmother this weekend.

Shortcut:

- **Will** = Guess (andar ka jyotish baba) or promise.

- **Going to** = Plan (already decide kar liya).

Example Sentences (20)

Using “Will” (Prediction / Promise / Instant Decisions)

- (1) I will help you. = मैं तुम्हारी मदद करूँगा।
- (2) She will call you later. = वह तुम्हें बाद में कॉल करेगी।
- (3) We will go to the party tomorrow. = हम कल पार्टी में जाएंगे।
- (4) He will be a doctor one day. = वह एक दिन डॉक्टर बनेगा।
- (5) The sun will rise at 6 A.M. = सूरज सुबह 6 बजे उगेगा।
- (6) Don't worry, I will do it. = चिंता मत करो, मैं कर लूँगा।
- (7) Will you marry me? = क्या तुम मुझसे शादी करोगी? ॐ
- (8) Prices will increase next year. = अगले साल दाम बढ़ेंगे।
- (9) It will rain soon. = जल्दी बारिश होगी।
- (10) I think India will win the match. = मुझे लगता है भारत मैच जीतेगा।

Using “Going to” (Plans / Intentions)

- (11) I am going to study tonight. = मैं आज रात पढ़ने वाला हूँ।
- (12) She is going to visit her aunt. = वह अपनी आंटी से मिलने वाली है।
- (13) We are going to buy a new car. = हम नई कार खरीदने वाले हैं।
- (14) He is going to start a business. = वह बिज़नेस शुरू करने वाला है।
- (15) They are going to travel to Goa. = वे गोवा घूमने वाले हैं।
- (16) I am going to eat pizza. = मैं पिज़्ज़ा खाने वाला हूँ।
- (17) She is going to learn English. = वह अंग्रेज़ी सीखने वाली है।
- (18) We are going to clean the house. = हम घर साफ करने वाले हैं।
- (19) He is going to play football. = वह फुटबॉल खेलने वाला है।
- (20) I am going to meet my teacher. = मैं अपने शिक्षक से मिलने वाला हूँ।

Funny Recap (Arre Yaar Style)

Boss, ab future ka confusion duur:

- **Will** = "Guess / Promise / Turant Decision"
Example: It will rain today. I will call you.
- **Going to** = "Plan already bana liya"
Example: I am going to eat samosas tonight.
